NOTICE TO ALL MEMBERS---UPCOMING EVENT

As most of you know by now, Bill Beall and I will be driving The Chief and Bill's RV to Victoria, TX on Friday, 12 October in order to participate in "The Parade That Never Was" which is being sponsored by "The Warrior's Weekend" association (they host fishing trips at no cost, for soldiers wounded in Iraq and Afghanistan). They are assisted by the Victoria VFW, the Victoria American Legion, and the City of Victoria and probably other sponsors I don't yet know about.

The purpose of the parade is to honor all the Vietnam Veterans who came home from the war and never had a parade. The parade is scheduled to begin at 1000 hours on Saturday, 13 October, followed by a luncheon at the Victoria Community Center at noon. We will depart for home after the luncheon.

We will be departing VFW 8541 at approximately noon on Friday, 12 October. On that night (Friday night) we have all been invited to a steak dinner at the Victoria American Legion Post and for those of us from Chapter XV and VFW 8541, the steak dinner is free (although I'm sure they would accept donations) in appreciation for our attending and bringing The Chief. VFW 8541 Commander Jesse Dominguez needs a head count and names of those who plan to attend for three reasons:

#1: To provide the American Legion with an accurate count of how many dinners they will be preparing.

#2: In order to reserve a block of rooms at the Victoria Holiday Inn (?) at a special reduced price. Let me know if you want a room or if you want to sleep in the bed of The Chief?

#3: So that the names of those in attendance may be read as we pass in front of the viewing stand.

At this time the info I have so far is sketchy and Jesse assures me he will have additional info soon. Please respond ASAP if you plan to attend so that I can compile the list for Jesse to send to Victoria.

Suggested uniform of the day for the parade would be Green Berets or other appropriate Vietnam era headgear (for those of us who don't wear the beret) and military shirts/jackets from the Vietnam era, and / or complete uniforms if you have them.

Again, please let me know ASAP if you plan to join us. Knowing how comfortable the ride is in the back of The Chief, I doubt we will have many who will want to make the trip to Victoria (and return) in the truck bed. We have limited space in Bill Beall's RV. Therefore, depending on the number of members who wish to attend we may end up in a convoy of multiple vehicles to Victoria. It is approximately 115 miles from VFW 8541 to Victoria, and at Mach 1 in The Chief it shouldn't take us more than about 2 hours and 45 minutes (not counting Dos Equis rest stops.

The Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant

The Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant is designed to provide a one time monetary educational grant. The number of grants and the amounts will be determined by the chapter Scholarship Committee and with the approval of the chapter president. Recipient (s) will normally be announced at the Annual Installation of Officers Banquet in December.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants must be an SFA member in good standing, a legal dependant of such a member or a grandchild.
- 2. A high school graduate or a student anticipating graduation during the year of application.
- 3. The grant must be used to attend an accredited college, university, or a vocational institution.

<u>Application Procedures:</u> Eligible applicants must submit the following information to the chapter president in person or P.O. Box 33782 San Antonio, Texas 78265-3782 * <u>no later than November 1</u> of any year.

- a. A personal letter detailing the applicant's educational plans, career aspirations and planned use of the grant.
- b. Copies of the most recent academic transcripts, SAT scores and other scholastic achievements.
- c. A letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor or a principal.
- d. A summary of extra-curricular activities, non-academic achievements and/or hobbies


