MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

It is my sad duty to report the death of a chapter member, Lyle G. Sloan who died in March of 2012 at his home in Lytle, Texas and was interred at Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery with full military honors and surrounded by his family, chapter members and special friends. Lyle joined the Army in 1964 and was assigned to the 82ND Abn. Division. Sometime later he graduated from the Special Forces "Q" Course with honors. He served with the 5th Special Forces Group in Vietnam with the Hatchet Force as team leader out of Ban Me Thout. He was a proud member of the "Alamo Chapter" for many years. After retiring from the service, he taught SROTC along with Henry Jimenez at St. Mary's University. Lyle presented a rough exterior but he had a generous soul and made monetary donations to our chapter often, and although he used colorful language when he spoke, he was a gentle and affable person. He ran the race, never faltered and completed the mission. No one can ask more of a soldier. Rest in peace brother, all your trials and tribulations are now over. We shall remember you and you will be missed.

On April 14th we held our annual memorial service dedicated to our fallen SF brothers and spouses. We had a large crowd on hand and were privileged to have had Major General Trombitas, Commander of Army South and chapter XV member joining us. After a solemn ceremony with taps and roll call, we placed a red rose on the graves of those chapter members and spouses that are buried here at Ft. Sam Cemetery. After the service, we reassembled at the VFW for a light lunch and appropriate cold beverages.

In April we held a planning meeting for the Convention 2013 Committee and had over 30 people attending. We are making a lot of progress with our planning and we promise to provide all attendees with a great and enjoyable convention. Most of our activities except for the Golf Tournament are centralized along the famous San Antonio River. We are asking all SF chapters to sponsor a golf hole for \$100. 
