
Free Flu Shots

The cold and flu season is upon us and the Department of Veterans Affairs has once again teamed up with Walgreens Pharmacies to allow all veterans who are currently enrolled in the VA healthcare system to be able walk into any of the over 8,000 Walgreens nationally to <u>receive a vaccination at no cost.</u> Vaccinations will be available through March 31, 2017.

Veterans wishing to receive the no-cost vaccination simply need to present a Veterans Identification Card and a photo ID at any participating Walgreens. After the Walgreens pharmacist administers the vaccine, Walgreens will transmit that information securely to VA where it becomes part of the patient's electronic medical record.

Scholarship Grants

The Board has approved revised requirements for the Chapter XV Education Grants. Thanks to the Scholarship Committee (Pat Connolly, Dan Hopgood, Henry Jimenez) for working out the new eligibility guidelines. Applications are being accepted from now until 15 November. Below are the revised guidelines.



Special Forces Chapter XV Education Grant

The Special Forces Chapter XV Education Grant is designed to provide a one-time education grant of a minimum of five hundred dollars (\$500.) The number and amount of grants are determined by the Chapter Scholarship Selection Committee with the approval of the Chapter president. Recipients will be announced at the annual Installation of Officers/ Christmas Banquet.

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a SFA member or legal dependent or grandchild of a Chapter member in good standing.
- 2. A high school student anticipating graduation during the school year of application.
- 3. Grant must be used to attend an accredited college, university or vocational institution.
- 4. Eligible applicants must submit the following:
 - A personal letter detailing the applicant's education plans, career aspirations, school they plan to attend, and planned use for the grant.
 - b. Copies of the most recent academic transcripts, SAT scores and other scholastic achievements, and a recent photograph.
 - c. Two letters of reference from a teacher, school counselor or principal.
 - d. A summary of extracurricular activities, non-academic achievements and hobbies.
 - e. A copy of the application to the school or the acceptance letter.
 Applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than 15 November. Send to


