## <u>SFA Chapter XV Nomination Process for Election of the 2015</u> <u>Officer Sequence of Events</u>

### **July 2014 Meeting** - Announce the Upcoming Election of Officers. Present the informal Preliminary State of Officers for 2015. Inform the Membership a Formal Preliminary Slate will Be introduced at the August Meeting and we will also begin accepting nominations for the Final Slate of Nominees. Announce the Elections in the Chapter Newsletter.

- <u>Aug. 2014 Meeting</u> Call for nominations in each of the Elective Positions. Inform the Membership of the Current Preliminary Slate and advise that Nominations will again be accepted in September and afterwards the Nominations will be closed. Once again have the upcoming elections announced in the Chapter Newsletter to all members.
- **Sept. 2014 Meeting** Call for nominations in each of the Elective Positions for the Final Slate of Officers for 2015. Once completed inform the Membership of the Final Slate of Nominees and announce that the Nominations are now closed. The Nominations Committee Chairman will prepare a Final Slate of Nominees in Ballot form to be Presented to the Membership at the October Meeting for distribution to the Chapter members. Continue to announce the elections in the Newsletter. The Final Ballot will be included in the Newsletter to the Membership in October.
- <u>Oct. 2014 Meeting</u> Announce to the Membership the Ballots will be in the October Newsletter for Distribution to the Membership. Inform the members that all ballots **must be returned** to the Teller Committee by the date of the <u>November Membership</u> Meeting in order to be validated and counted




