Inform the Membership a Formal Preliminary Slate will Be introduced at the August Meeting and we will also begin accepting nominations for the Final Slate of Nominees. Announce the Elections in the Chapter Newsletter.

Aug. 2014 Meeting - Call for nominations in each of the Elective Positions. Inform the Membership of the Current Preliminary Slate and advise that Nominations will again be accepted in September and afterwards the Nominations will be closed. Once again have the upcoming elections announced in the Chapter Newsletter to all members.

Sept. 2014 Meeting - Call for nominations in each of the Elective Positions for the Final Slate of Officers for 2015. Once completed inform the Membership of the Final Slate of Nominees and announce that the Nominations are now closed. The Nominations Committee Chairman will prepare a Final Slate of Nominees in Ballot form to be Presented to the Membership at the October Meeting for distribution to the Chapter members. Continue to announce the elections in the Newsletter. The Final Ballot will be included in the Newsletter to the Membership in October.

Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant

The Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant is designed to provide a onetime educational grant of a minimum of five hundred dollars (\$500). The number and amount of grants are determined by the chapter Scholarship Selection Committee with the approval of the chapter president. Recipient(s) will be announced at the annual Installation of Officers/Christmas Banquet.

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be an SFA member in good standing, a legal dependent, or a grandchild.
- 2. A high school graduate or a student anticipating graduation during the school year of application.
- 3. Grant must be used to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational institution.
- 4. Eligible applicants must submit the following:
 - a. A personal letter detailing the applicant's educational plans, career aspirations, and planned use for the grant awarded.
 - b. Copies of the most recent academic transcripts, SAT scores, and other scholastic achievements.
 - c. A letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, or a principal.
 - d. A summary of extra-curricular activities, non-academic achievements, and hobbies.
 - e. A copy of the acceptance letter from the institution of higher learning the applicant will attend.
- 5. Above criteria must be received by the scholarship committee no later than 15 November. Send to:


