Chapter XV General Membership Meeting June 1, 2013

Meeting was called to order by President Chuck Rose at 1300 hours. After Pledge of Allegiance and invocation by Chaplain Rudy Johnson, there was a moment of silence for fallen comrades and spouses. Chuck Rose introduced **guest speaker** J.R.Garza, DAV Service officer and head of the "Names with Faces" Project. He and his associates, Charlie Calderon and Sylvia Spadlin, explained the project's mission to collect ID's and photos of Vietnam casualties from the San Antonio area. They presented to the Chapter a copy of their database, containing names and photos of 361 KIAs and 9 MIAs from the San Antonio area. They are still looking for 3 people.

<u>Guests:</u> Two guests from C-1-19 SFGA, SGM Garza and MSG Pusar, were introduced. They will provide ODA support for SFA Convention 2013.

<u>Sick and in distress</u>: Bob Hand had the surgery for his hip replacement but has lost use of his right arm. David Benavides is scheduled to undergo thyroid surgery.

OLD BUSINESS: Approval of minutes was moved by J.W. Martin, seconded by Rudy Johnson and approved by the membership. Treasurer Mario Guerra reported a healthy financial outlook for both Chapter and Convention.

Chuck reported 2 new members and 3 applications pending; total chapter membership is approximately 215. Newsletter: Editor Mike Maloy was absent but left word that pictures from Memorial Day ceremony will be in next month's newsletter.

Chuck said those who missed the Jack Hogue Picnic missed "one hell of a party" and commended Bob Hand and wife Penny for excellent planning and execution. The annual picnic attracted SFA members from the Houston, Austin, Killeen and Dallas chapters, and all offered their help with Convention.

Chapter had good representation at the FSH Memorial Day ceremony, with lots of green berets in the crowd. Raul De la Garza is working on repairs to the "war Wagon."

Bill Smith announced the Christmas Banquet will be Dec. 7.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: After 15-minute break, Rudy Johnson made a motion to induct John Woodworth, general manager of the Esquire Tavern, as an honorary member of SFA. Bobby Walker seconded, and the membership approved after some discussion about requirements for honorary and associate membership. Chuck said Woodworth has arranged for donation of approximately \$30,000 in goods and services for the Convention.

Convention Chairman Fred Solis led a committee-by-committee review of plans and progress for each Convention event. He said we are "98% there" in preparation. Chuck and Fred emphasized that attendees will be required to show official name tags with appropriate icons for admission to all Convention events -- even free events. Buses will shuttle continuously among Hyatt Regency, Grand Hyatt and El Tropicano hotels from 8 a.m.to midnight each day of the convention. Also, there will be bus transportation to the Golf Tournament, some ladies events, the Picnic and the VFW Post 76 Cookout. The banquet will be open seating, except reserved seats for VIPs and Chapter XV members.

Eileen Trevino of DAR said a flag flown over the Alamo will be presented to the Chapter in memory of Armando Canales during the Alamo Ceremony June 29.

OPEN FORUM: Len Czarnecki reminded that Flag Day is June 14. Meeting adjourned at 1500 hours after motion by Len and second by Dan Hopgood.




