We learned of Ralph Williams' passing. **OLD BUSINESS**  Approval of September minutes was moved by J.W. Martin, seconded by Marsha Scott. Approved. □ Financial Report on SFA Convention 2013 by Buddy Gee: Total income was \$172,884. Total expenses \$133,655. Net income \$39,329. The 50% paid to SFA National came to \$19,664. Chapter XV Net income \$19,665. Report will be added to After Action Report and sent to National and to chapters planning future conventions. ☐ Chapter Treasurer's Report by Mario Guerra was approved by the members. ■ Membership Report by Marsha Scott: We have 187 members and 5 widows on the roster. One new Life Member is Rudy Villareal. Dues are now due.... Chuck said someone needs to step in as membership chairman for about a year, as Marti wants to take a break. He also asked for volunteers to serve on a committee to update the roster. ☐ Scholarship Committee: The scholarship application will be e-mailed to members and put into next newsletter. Applications will be accepted until the last day of November. Scholarship grant will be awarded at Christmas Banquet. Alex Flores is committee chairman. □ Nominations Committee: Buddy Gee again presented the slate of officers for 2014: **President, Chuck Rose Vice President, Bill Smith** Secretary, Bob Hand **Treasurer, Mario Guerra** Sergeant at Arms, Pat Connolly **Assistant Secretary, Barry Archer Assistant Treasurer, Buddy Gee** Assistant Sergeant at Arms, Raul de la Garza Gee said Len Czarnecki had nominated Bill Smith for President at the September meeting, but Smith declined. Chuck opened the floor for other nominations.

There were none. Dan Hopgood moved that nominations close, seconded by Marsha Scott. After discussion, the motion was approved. Ballots were distributed. Ballots will also be attached to the newsletter and will be available at the Nov. 2 meeting, when the election will be held. Dan noted that election requires votes of at least 10% of the membership, and a SFA membership number is required to vote.   Oktoberfest: Board voted to contribute \$200 to VFW for this annual event.

NEW BUSINESS:  Jerrie LeBleu was recommended by the board for chapter honorary membership, pending a dispute with National over her qualifications for Associate Member. After discussion, members voted to make her an honorary member.
□ Chuck wants to have a cadre of chapter members who will visit injured SF soldiers at SAMMC and help their families. Commanders of both 7th Group and 5th Group have requested assistance, as government funds are curtailed for commanders to visit these troops. Chuck said Green Beret Foundation will assist in this effort. Victor Perales, retired from 7th Group and now teaching trauma medicine at FSH, volunteered his services, as did J.W. Martin. Marsha Scott read a letter she has written to SFA requesting an annual wreath ceremony each Aug. 20 at the gravesite of Martha Raye ("Col. Maggie") in the main post cemetery at Fort Bragg Bob Hand said next year's Jack Hogue Picnic is tentatively set for May 16-18 Steve Twining has a video of a 1964 Vietnam action that he is willing to share with members (the mission for which Vince Skeeba received the Silver Star.)

Thousands of dollars in donated cash, products and services enabled the 2013 SFA Convention Committee to provide many complimentary services and upgrades. These enhancements included the following:

- No charge for the Welcome Reception
- Ladies program was no charge (except for a Dutch treat luncheon)
- · Live band nightly in the hospitality room
- Nearly nonstop bus service between the convention hotel and the overflow hotels
- On-site security

In addition to cash from sponsors, the following goods and services were donated:

- Beer, wine and liquor at an estimated value of \$40,000 +/-
- Starbucks Coffee and pastries daily in the hospitality room: \$5,000
- Pickles and peppers donated by Bill Snyder, El Paso Chapter IX, estimated retail value: \$900

# **Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant**

The Special Forces Chapter XV Educational Grant is designed to provide a one-time educational grant of a minimum of five hundred dollars (\$500). The number and amount of grants are determined by the chapter Scholarship Selection Committee with the approval of the chapter president. Recipient(s) will be announced at the annual Installation of Officers/Christmas Banquet.

#### Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be an SFA member in good member in good standing, a legal dependent, or a grandchild.
- 2. A high school graduate or a student anticipating graduation during the school year of application.
- 3. Grant must be used to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational institution.
- 4. Eligible applicants must submit the following:
  - a. A personal letter detailing the applicant's educational plans, career aspirations, and planned use for the grant awarded.
  - b. Copies of the most recent academic transcripts, SAT scores, and other scholastic achievements.
  - c. A letter of reference from a teacher, school counselor, or a principal.
  - d. A summary of extra-curricular activities, non academic achievements, and hobbies.
  - e. A copy of the acceptance letter from the institution of higher learning the applicant will attend.
- 5. Above criteria must be received by the scholarship committee no later than 29 November Send to:
